

Sliding Fee Scale Application

Do you receive any of the following? :

If you answered YES to any of the above questions, you are NOT *eligible for the CAP program. However, you are possibly *eligible for FamilyCare's Sliding Fee Scale Program.

* Eligible – meaning that your income and assets meet the criteria.

To be eligible for either program, you have to be an established patient at FamilyCare. To be eligible for the CAP program you have to be at least 19 years of age and a West Virginia resident. If you are under 19 years of age you may be eligible for CHIP. Please ask a FamilyCare staff member for an application.

Please attach ANY of the following sources of income* that apply to ALL persons in the household ...

90 days consecutive/current proof of income for any income that is being received in the household.

a letter from your employer on company letterhead stating your start date and hourly rate and how many hours a week you average.

If anyone receives Social Security or Social Security Disability, please attach a copy of their current Social Security Awards letter.

A copy of everyone's most recent federal Income tax return. (1040 form) NO W-2's
If you are self-employed, please attach your most recent Schedule-C tax return form along with your 1040 form.

Please attach any of the following highlighted items

*Income is...

- money earned before taxes (gross income)
- self-employment income (current Schedule-C Tax Return form)
- child support and/or alimony (court order and current statement)
- retirement
- Social Security (SSI or SSDI) (current Awards letter)
- seasonal employment income
- cash value of Food Stamps (current statement with amount)
- or any other source of money your family uses to live on

- unemployment
- Worker's Compensation
- interest from savings
- dividends from investments
- rental income
- welfare assistance (copy of utility and/or housing)
- financial assistance from any person(s)

If you receive ANY of the above-asked items, you have to provide verification/proof of income and/or source of income. If you receive income from someone, you will have to get a current notarized statement from that person, stating how much they give to you on a monthly basis and what it goes towards.

If you do NOT have these documents, your application will be considered incomplete and will NOT be processed.
